



THREE-YEAR RESIDENTIAL DOCTORAL PROGRAM STARTS THIS FALL

WHAT: A residential Doctor of Education Degree in Sports Management program is starting Sept. 6, 2011 on the Daphne, Ala., campus.

WHEN: Courses are 6-8 p.m. Mondays-Thursdays during the Fall, Spring and Summer Semesters.

WHO: Five new Graduate Assistants will participate. Local students can join them in the residential program or in individual courses being offered during that academic semester.

ONLINE OPTION: Courses will be streamed live over the Internet, like a webinar, and recorded for future viewing. This will allow other students to form a group, who cannot be on campus, to go through the course work for the residential program together. Individual students can also follow the program online.
